- a. Continue the activities of the RSR program, update the program by end of October and provide advice to the Chairman on the issues handled by the RSRP.
- b. Continue with the introduction of the Total System Approach and the alignment and maintenance of the Qatar Aviation Regulatory structure and regulations to the EU/EASA regulatory structure and regulation. (safety, security, air transport etc.).
- c. Assist and advise to/ liaise with QCAA departments on the implementation of the new regulations. Initiate actions and start coordination mechanism across main impacted departments, taking into account the new QCAA structure during and QCAA strategy to ensure implementation of regulatory structure.
